Combined reports are compiled by by the primary contributing professional(s), with input from the inter-professional team. One set of harmonized recommendations are made. Educators can access ongoing support in implementing report recommendations.

A Registered Nurse provides confidential, timely and accessible (video, text, phone) health education and health literary support to students and/or school staff.

A help-phone model, focused on health education. If a student or staff member has a question and wants reliable, confidential advice, it is available as and when needed.

The registered nurse can provide continuity of support as needed.
